Trees for Augusta Champion and Notable Tree FAQ

Where are the boundaries for trees eligible to submit?

Trees for Augusta will accept nominations of trees in Richmond County in Georgia and in western Aiken County in South Carolina.

What qualifies as a notable tree?

The criteria for a notable tree are uniqueness in the area, role as a neighborhood or private property landmark, and relation to local history. These qualities are subject to Trees for Augusta, Inc. review and final determination.

What qualifies as a champion tree?

A tree is considered a champion if it is the largest of its kind, measured by height, crown, and size of trunk 4.5 feet above ground level. Trees for Augusta, Inc. can assist in measuring tree size.
